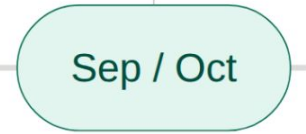

- How to assess the size of the community and the size of the programme?
- How to assess PAAP's growing trajectory over the years? Can we speculate on where we are heading?
- What do we need to pitch from bucket 2? How do we address UKRI and governmental priorities?
