

Doctoral Training Partnerships (DTP):

studentships

- 220 3.5 year studentships funded each year
 - Theory has 34 / year in latest round
- Distributed amongst eligible departments by algorithm
- Inputs to algorithm are updated every two years
- Departments can award for 3, 3.5 or 4 years as desired.

- 5 awarded each year; 50% success rate

- Annual call (usually for end September each year)

 - SEAB recommendation so we can demonstrate quality of training
- Accreditation will cover
 - no. hours of (research, skills) training available
 - the student training environment
- Community consultation held in October 2015




Fees only studentship pilot: Possible

- Discussions on extending eligibility for fees only studentships to non-EU students
- ETCC and SEAB have recommended a pilot, provided BIS response is positive (not adopted by other research councils)

70% of students stay in research as a first destination 20% of students ultimately stay in academia.

Return to Research bursaries

- Eligibility: >=2 years break from academia (normally).
- Costs for visiting host institution (including childcare) to prepare case for funding/ fellowship application
- Up to £2500 available, to be used for up to 6 months

Daphne Jackson Fellowships

- Part time fellowships enabling applicant to return to research
- Eligibility:>=2 years break from academia
- Fellowships are held for 2 years, with an additional third funded at 50-100%
 FTE.

Returner Fellowships

studentships

- Additional fellowships on top of ERF, to be awarded to outstanding candidates returning from a career break or working outside research
- Eligibility; >=2 years away from research (normally)
- Applicants will be judged on track record prior to career break
- Fellowships may be held for 1-5 years.
